

The Association of Surveyors of Papua New Guinea (ASPNG) wishes to invite its members, allied professionals, and interested individuals to present papers at its 57th Annual Survey Congress, which will be held at the Lamana Hotel in Port Moresby from October 15th to 17th, 2025.

The theme for this year's congress is "Traversing the Future: An evolutionary look at the survey industry – past, present, and future". The theme examines the evolution of the (land) surveying industry, from traditional chain and compass methods to modern GNSS and GIS technologies. It highlights how surveying practices have adapted to advancements in instrumentation, data processing, and spatial analysis, reflecting on past techniques, current standards, and future trends in the profession. It also delves into the existing land survey legislation and discusses its currency, how it may accommodate new survey techniques and technology, consequently, culminating in its review.

The Congress Manager hereby requests authors to present an abstract briefly describing the aspect of the paper. The abstract should have a maximum of 200 words and be written in English. Participants who wish to contribute oral and poster presentations and trade exhibitions are most welcome.
